

This visual guide will help you get to know the Prado museum.


You can use it before, during and after your visit.


The guide consists of several chapters, each with a distinctive colour.

Each chapter contains a specific number of factsheets.

To prepare the guide, we suggest you follow these steps:

- 1. Print the whole guide or only the chapters you need.
- 2. The printed size is 2 factsheets per page. If you can, print on both sides of the paper for ease of handling.
- 3. Cut each printed page in half along the dotted line.





How to use and prepare the guide

- 4. You can laminate the factsheets to prevent them getting damaged.
- 5. Sort the factsheets by chapter colour and then by number.
- 6. You can ring bind them for easier handling.
- 7. The guide is now ready to use.



Las Meninas by the painter Diego Velázquez







We see a group of people who lived in King Philip IV's palace.

In the centre is the Infanta Margarita. The meninas are the young women beside her. They look after and play with Margarita.

Behind them is a mirror with the king and queen's reflection. The Spanish painter Velázquez is in the painting too.

Velázquez painted many portraits of kings and queens, nobles and jesters. Lots of artists, like Picasso and Dalí, admired his paintings.

The picture is painted in oil on canvas.

This painting tells a mythological story. Minerva is the goddess of war and wisdom. Arachne is a woman who is very good at weaving.







The man is walking in the countryside with birds and beaks, in the garden with green grass.


The man is sitting on pigeons and feathers.

I painted it by myself.


